About the position

Lead this subcommittee whose work impacts most ophthalmologists including development of national datasets for use in electronic medical records and clinical audits. Liaising with international and national stakeholders to support and input into best practice standards or guidance on informatics, clinical audit and effectiveness in ophthalmology to improve services for patients. It also provides a link with industry stakeholders to communicate the needs of the ophthalmology profession, facilitate problem solving and promote consistency in implementation across different providers. The work has been instrumental in establishing an NHS England project on imaging interoperability and establishing the SNOMED International Eye Care Clinical Reference Group.

Criteria for position

- Fellow or Member
- Broad experience in clinical informatics and digital audit. It is appreciated that informatics is a broad field (see RCOphth Healthcare Informatics document) and that applicants are unlikely to have extensive experience in all aspects. Applicants should have strong experience in some aspects of informatics and audit, and at least peripheral knowledge across all aspect.
- Prior committee experience is desirable.
- Demonstrate an ability to work with multi-disciplinary groups, e.g. with non-clinical informaticians and industry partners.
